Located at the MOWA Trailer Pre-Race 2: Pill Draw / Registration Opens 5:15pm

Pre-Race 3: Warm-ups (Engine Heat) - PRIOR TO PRACTICE All Safety Equipment Strongly Recommended!

Pre-Race 4: Driver's Meeting (Pill Draw Closes at 6:05pm) 6:15pm Located at MOWA Trailer

Event 1: Practice 6:30pm Practice with your assigned Heat Race

Event 2: Heat Races (10L) 7:15pm For Race Format - See "Passing Points Format" Highest in Passing Points draws Invert Pill

Event 3: Fast Dash (6L / 6 cars)

Event 4: B-Main (12L if one (1) / 10L if two (2)) For Race Format - See "Passing Points Format"

Event 5: A-Main (30L / 20 cars)

# **Modified Passing Points Format (see diagram for specifics)**

0-21 Entries = Two (2) Heats | Heat Winners + 4 to Fast Dash | Pos. 7-21: Heads up by Total Passing Points

22-31 Entries = Three (3) Heats | Heat Winners + 3 to Fast Dash | Pos. 7-16 Direct Transfer to "A" | Pos. 17-20 Transfer from "B-Main"

32-44 Entries = Four (4) Heats | Heat Winners + 2 to Fast Dash | Pos. 7-16 Directly Transfer to "A" | Pos. 17-20 Transfer from Two (2) "B-Mains"

45-60 Entries = Five (5) Heats | Top 30 to Three (3) Qualifiers | 31-60 to two (2) C-Mains (Top three (3) to Qualifiers) | Top seven (7) from Qualifiers to A

Only rull intermets of the Midwest Open wheel Association are engine for Championship Points, Contingency Awards, and/or Tow Mioney							
Attempt to Qualify	<u>Mufflers</u>						
*Once a car/driver combination attempts to qualify during either a Heat Race							
or a Time Trial attempt, no car changes	*NOT REQUIRED FOR THIS EVENT						
<u>Raceceiver</u>	<u>Shocks</u>						
*Mandatory - Frequency 454.0000	*Cockpit adjustable shocks allowed						
<u>Drag Links</u>	<u>Ballast</u>						
*Must be tethered to frame	*Bolt-on ballast must be painted white and be between axles						
Torsion Arm Stops	<u>Seats</u>						
*Required for both sides of front torsion bar	*Must be MOWA-approved Full Containment Seat						
<u>Tires</u>	Wings						
*FRONT: HOOSIER 85/8.0-15 D12, D15, D20	*No Wicker on Dished Wing (no Dished Wings in 2015!)						
* <u>LEFT REAR:</u> HOOSIER 15.0/96-15 H12, H15	*MAX 1" Wicker on Flat Wing						
*RIGHT REAR: HOOSIER 105/16.0-15 H15, H20, MED	*No Wicker Limitation on Front Wing						

#### **Safety Harness**

\*Minimum of an SFI 16.5 or SFI 16.1 approved restraint system, until the date of the belt expiration (two years from the date of manufacturer)

\*Fasteners must be magnetic steel unless using type of mount in which the seat belt wraps around the roll cage

\*A seven-point harness is recommended

### **Electronics / Traction Control**

\*No Traction Control, No electronic/CPU engine/fuel/chassis controls

\*MOWA Sprint Car Series officials may, at any time, confiscate 1) Ignition Box and 2) Tachometer at any time provided like replacement parts are made available to the competitor

\*Any competitor may present anonymous \$50 protest fee provided like replacement parts are made available to the competitor

#### A-Main Work Area & Courtesy Laps

\*A-Main Work Area opens once the first car is pushed off for the A-Main

\*Two (2) courtesy laps are given one (1) time per caution period once the lineup is set for any car(s) in the Work Area \*Courtesy laps are only awarded after the event's Initial Green Flag

# **Provisional Starters**

\*Generally, no Provisional Starters are allowed

\*Track must approve at Driver's Meeting

\*If Provisonals are used, there must be two (2)

\*21st is highest car in current MOWA Points

\*22nd is track option

\*This also applies to a short field if a B-Main is cancelled

# **35-Minute Fuel Stop Rule**

\*Clock starts once last car is pushed from Staging

\*Clock stops when no cars are running under Red

\*If race is stopped after 35-minutes, Fuel Stop Flag is displayed

\*Two (2) Minute Clock for fuel starts when all crews are at car

\*Once Two (2) Minute Clock expires, crews still working at push off are deemed to be in A-Main Work Area and restart at the tail

## 8-Minute Warning Horn

\*Event is broken into thirds - Heats, Dash/B-Main, A-Main \*Cars not ready to push from staging start at the tail

#### **A-Main Alternates**

\*If one (1) B-Main, first B-Main NQ \*2 B-Mains, highest in MOWA Points of each B-Main first NQ

# Scoring

\*All cars must complete first lap to have single-file restart \*75% of field must cross start/finish to complete a lap

# Single-file Restarts - through Restart Cone

\*Nose-to-tail through Cone - breaking plane of back bumper = jump \*Two (2) jumps in any one (1) event is a disqualification

# **Caution Rules**

\*All lapped cars stay in the restart order until there are five (5) laps or less remaining

\*Any car that stops with contact restarts at the tail

\*Two (2) charged cautions = disqualification

\*Any car that spins/stops to avoid an in-progress accident without making contact at the accident scene will be given spot back as running on prior lap

\*If three (3) or more cars are involved on initial start, all cars get spot back but are still charged toward Two (2) charged cautions (if two (2) or less are involved, all cars restart at the tail)

Driver that earns points FIRST wins a TIE | \*If you scratch (DNS), you receive ZERO (0.0) Points\*

flyou 1) Elect to start on the rear or 2) Miss the Draw, you will only receive Finish Position Points (DIAGONAL)

fl you know you want to start in the rear (rookie, car isn't running right), don't draw! Please ask to start the rear!
